

STANDARDS



All Living on Water moorings are overseen by Scottish Canals (SC) to ensure that they offer safe, friendly and well-maintained places to live.

To give all residents real peace of mind, SC operates a set of standards for the boats on its moorings. These ensure that all Living on Water moorings remain high-quality sites that are a pleasure to live on.

SC's standards ensure that all boats on Living on Water moorings complement the local environment and:

- Are safe, of good quality and kept in excellent order.
- Have paint and varnish work that is of a good standard and that is maintained regularly.
- Have external fixtures and fittings that are of a good quality and that are in good decorative order.
- Are in keeping and of similar appearance to the other boats in the locale.

Please note: To ensure that these standards are complied with properly, the final decision as to the acceptability of the vessel will lie with SC. Should any boat fall into disrepair then SC will send notice to the owner to give them a three-month period to return the boat to an acceptable standard. Should the owner not comply with SC's requests then the licence will not be renewed.
